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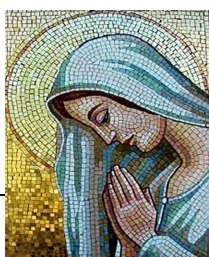

STEP INTO PREP!



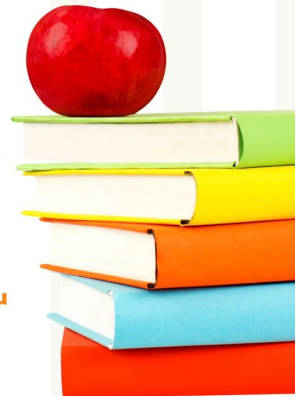
We're excited to announce our program for children starting school in 2021 – **'Step into Prep'**.
