Return to School

Whilst, on the whole, most students have returned to school with confidence and have settled into the routines well. During this time, it is so important to make sure that the students are eating well and getting plenty of sleep each day to prepare them for the day ahead. We have noticed that many students, in particular the younger ones, are very tired and some are showing resistance about coming to school each day. These are often the behaviours that we are used to seeing by about Week 3 or 4 in Term 1 of a school year. So given the year that we have had, these behaviours are not surprising.

As parents, we ask you to encourage your child to be at school every day to make the most of this term's face-to-face learning. Be strong and have this expectation of your child. Although they may leave you upset in the mornings, the usual pattern is that they are fine once they settle into the classroom. (We would always ring you if they did not settle). And can I ask that you don't suggest to your child that if they are feeling worse throughout the day, get your teacher to ring home. You can put money on it that they will be feeling worse!! It might be an idea to send me a text to let me know that your child is not 100% so that we know and can keep an eye on them for you.

Of course, as our Schools Operations Guide states that parents are asked to keep your child at home if they are not feeling well, even with the mildest symptoms. But if they are well, we need them here, at school every day. Their friends need them here, as well as their teachers, so that we can finish off what has been a year with a difference!

TUESDAY 3RD NOVEMBER (Melbourne Cup)


In addition to these days, I have given teachers a report writing day on


Around Australia Challenge





